- Table 1. Classification of Dogs with Thoracolumbar Disk Disease
- Group 1. Hyperesthesia with no neurologic deficits
- Group 2. Ambulatory paraparesis (incomplete loss of voluntary motor function in the pelvic limbs. Urinary/ fecal continence and pain sensation are intact.
- Group 3. Nonambulatory paraparesis. Urinary/fecal continence and pain sensation are intact.
- Group 4. Paraplegia (complete loss of voluntary motor function in the pelvic limbs). Urinary/fecal continence is generally lost and pain sensation is intact.
- Group 5. Paraplegia with loss of urinary/fecal continence and pain sensation.
